ANSWER KEY A noun that shows ownership is a possessive noun To turn a singular noun into a possessive noun, add an apostrophe (') and an - s example: The boy's wagon is in the garage To turn a plural noun that ends in -s into a possessive noun add an apostrophe (') after the -s example: The farmer painted horses' stables To turn a plural noun that does not end in -s into a possessive
